



Lake Courtesy Code

Please follow these common sense courtesies:

NOISE - Sound travels far over water.

- Recommended water skiing and personal water craft hours:
10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- QUIET hours please - after 10:00 p.m.

SPEED - Give other lake users a break.

- Slow down for safety, and to protect shorelines from erosion.
 - Watch for special no-wake zones and speed limits.

SPACE - Keep your distance.

- Stay at least 100 feet from swimmers, anglers, other watercraft, rafts or docks (*state law*).
 - Observe loons, eagles and other wildlife from a long distance.

CLEAN BOATS/CLEAN LAKES - It's up to us.

- Clean your boat, motor, trailer, anchor, and live well to prevent the spread of Eurasian water milfoil and other harmful, non-native species.
- Litter kills wildlife - if you can carry it in, you can carry it out

SAFETY - It's the law.

- New Law - As of May 1, 1995, one wearable personal flotation device is required for each person in a watercraft.
- Obey all boating laws - see the Wisconsin DNR Boating Regulations handbook.
